Have you Registered Yet? - Do you internet shop? If so, then please support Todwick Primary School by registering with TheGivingMachine. When you shop online from your favourite stores/internet sites, cash is donated to the school. It doesn't cost you a penny; you shop as usual from the store website.

How Does it Work? - When you buy online via TheGivingMachine, a sales commission is received from the participating shop. 75% of this is converted into a donation on your behalf and sent to Todwick Primary.
